

**UCMUG MEETING —Nov.18, 2008 — 6:30pm**

President Weaver opened the meeting by requesting a Treasurer's Report. Treasurer Bill Reichert reported today's balance is \$1,978.21 which included three new membership renewals minus the \$19.97 subscription expense of Macworld for the Tennessee Tech University Library. Weaver mentioned that the previous minutes are always shown on the UCMUG web page for referral. Woody Geisler moved and Larry Meyer seconded a motion to accept the Treasurer's and Secretary's Reports as presented. Motion passed unanimously!

The program for the evening was presented by Bob Weaver. He reviewed the many new features of Time Machine, the backup program that is supplied with the new Leopard operating system. Discussions revolved about its operation on a partitioned G4 or G5 hard drive or backup installed on a separate external drive. Questions about size and connections were discussed. The advantages and disadvantages of mechanical and solid state drives were reviewed especially for large quantities of photographs.

Bob projected the use and recall of many backup options. The backup can be set for any time interval the owner wishes — minutes, hours or days. A fanned, expansion of all the backups files can be shown and the one desired can be selected and opened.

A quick review of inexpensive or free third party software capturing web videos for playing on the computer were mentioned. These were Tube TV, Mac Tubes, and Chimosoft.

Before adjourning, we were reminded that we had agreed to have no regular December meeting.
