

**UCMUG MEETING — March 17, 2009 — 6:30pm**  
**At Cumberland Cove, Welcome Center**

Shortly after 6:30pm Bob Weaver opened the meeting acknowledging two guests, Sean & Eاون Monday the sons of member, Bill Monday. Asking for the Treasure's Report, Treasurer Bill Reihert reported a balance of \$2,058.21 and last month's minutes submitted by Warner Siebert and shown on the UCMUG web page were made a motion by Larry Meyers and seconded by Tina Geisler. Motion unanimously passed. Your Secretary, Rog Westlake, who has suffered from heart and prostrate problems these last two months, thanks you for all the kinds words you emailed and is glad to be back for the meetings.

President, Bob Weaver, used his laptop and projector to illustrate and compare web sites. He has investigated and set up several web sites for both business and personal showing the many factors and choices needed for installation. Apple recently announced the new I Macs, including the Mac Mini have been upgraded and come with IWEB software. Bob's own personal web site was built with IWEB. and he finds it a good one for a start. Apple has announced that this summer they will be releasing IWEB for I Phone. The language of IWEB is HTML and Hypertext.

Other programs generally increasing in price but possibly expanding in features are RAPID WEAVER [\$50), FREEWAY (open source) and DREAMWEAVER which is the de-facto standard for professionals. It is also the most expensive. One may go to the free internet web site of WORDPRESS, which is a blog. Many Web builders use this site to air their views, problems and solutions. This may be very helpful.

Bob showed that simple text, pictures and drop in graphics for making a web page are relatively easy with IWEB. DREAMWEAVER, the professional software allows for the most sophisticated and action graphics but probably not needed for or practical for a beginner.

Just before closing the meeting it was announced that the Satellite UCMUG Meeting will be at 3 pm at the Pleasant Hill Community Church UCC, on Saturday, March 28 at 3 PM.

Meeting closed about 8 pm but a number of members stayed for further discussion and questions for Bob.
