

**UCMUG MEETING — Sept. 16, 2008 — 6:30pm

President Bob Weaver opened the meeting commenting that though officer elections were scheduled to be held at this meeting further information was needed. With permission from the attending members he scheduled the election for next month's meeting. Members gave vocal agreement.

Bob reviewed the latest information about this month's APPLE releases. These are the newest versions of iPhone G3 and iPod Touch. Also released is the update for the Leopard operating system to version 10.5.5. A discussion of compatibility with older systems when updating was explored. The storage capacities of various network servers were discussed. Many servers offer a couple of gigabytes storage for customers. Google offers 2 gigabyte of storage at no extra charge . Also the local Frontier network offers 2 gigabyte storage per customer.

Bob stressed the need for the regular using of your Disk Utility — located in the Utilities folder within the Applications folder. Additional help in keeping the operating system and data orderly and cleaned up is to use AppleJack. It is a free download and can be found via Version Tracker or Google. Bob highlighted the use of AppleJack in minimizing system problems.

To help speed up computer work, Bob recommended the use of keyboard shortcuts which can save mouse hand/arm movements.. He downloaded Key Shortcuts from guides.macrumors.com. Printed a six page copy, duplicated and assembled copies for all the attendees. For those multi-tasking a number of computer projects these time saving hints will be greatly appreciated. Thanks, Bob, for your labor, generosity and thoughtfulness!
